## Jc ~ Newspaper Websites

Most of the information in this section has been provided by Arthur Robinson, an American Wodehousean who was for many years a Reference Librarian at the Lewis Library, LaGrange College, LaGrange, Georgia. He has undertaken a great deal of research on such sites in his private capacity, but feels compelled to point out that many of the databases can only be accessed by a library membership or a personal membership of the database concerned, usually requiring the payment of fees. Once accepted, in most data bases the simplest way to start is by an 'author' search, or a 'keyword' 'or full text' search.

The websites listed below generally cover multiple newspapers and journals, and the precise nature of the content of each may differ. Readers are recommended to check carefully the content and potential cost of subscriptions they propose to accept to ensure that they include access to the required publications.
