Note:

- 1 All of these titles were first published by A & C Black in the UK. The McIlvaine bibliography states that American editions were issued by Macmillan in New York using imported English sheets; it is assumed that the boards were also the same as the UK editions. We are unaware of any copies held by collectors, but McIlvaine seems to be correct, certainly for *Tales of St Austin's*, the publication of which by Macmillan was reported on p28 of the *New York Tribune* of 12 December 1903 (our thanks to Neil Midkiff for providing an image of the report). If dust jackets do exist for any of the books, it is assumed that they would have been illustrated by the same artist who was responsible for the book's boards and internal illustrations, as was the practice in the UK. (It seems that McIlvaine may actually have seen two of the US editions, as her entry for *The White Feather* states that A & C Black does not appear on the title page, and her entry for *Psmith Journalist* gives the Library of Congress card number.)
- 2 This publication of *Homeopathic Treatment* was produced by the magazine *Boy's Life*, in which the story had originally appeared. Its function seems to have been of a publicity nature, and as far as we can tell was never on sale separately.
- 3 The publication of *Dudley is Back to Normal* was produced solely to register the story for US Copyright protection, and it was never sold separately in the US.
- 4 All these titles represent editions published by Overlook in their 99-book series equivalent to the Everyman series in the UK. The titles mentioned here had not previously been published with these specific contents in the US, and have been included to represent the first editions to be published there.
